



ASIA MOUNTAIN BIKE SERIES – FACT SHEET

The ASIA MOUNTAIN BIKE SERIES 2018 is composed of a series of UCI regulated mountain bike races in different Asian host countries with the aim of providing a platform for especially Asian riders to earn valuable UCI points towards World Championships and the Olympics qualification. The series will create more arenas for mountain bike riders to compete and gain racing experiences other than the yearly Asian Mountain Bike Continental Championships.

Host Country Eligibility

The ASIA MTB SERIES 2018 is run **INDEPENDENTLY** with the same rules and regulation as a series in different Asian countries as per following APPLICATION eligibilities;

1. THE RACE MUST BE SANCTIONED UNDER UCI

- a. The race **MUST** be run according to the UCI Rules and Regulation
- b. The race **MUST** be registered to the UCI via the National Federation of each country
- c. The race will be regulated to follow the UCI standards by the UCI appointed Commissaires

2. ASIA COUNTRIES

- a. Only **ASIAN** countries is eligible to host the ASIA MTB SERIES
- b. A maximum of 4 ASIA MTB SERIES per nation per year is allowed to host the series
- c. Only **ASIAN NATIONALITY** (according to passport) is entitled to collect the series' POINTS and win the **OVERALL CHAMPION**

3. ONLY 2 DISCIPLINES WILL BE COUNTED IN THE SERIES

The organizer can have other disciplines and categories but only **2 disciplines** with the following categories will be counted in the series points

- a. **CROSS COUNTRY OLYMPICS**
 - i. Men Elite (19 years above)
 - ii. Women Elite (19 years above)
 - iii. Men Junior (17 & 18 years)
 - iv. Women Junior (17 & 18 years)
 - v. Men Master (30 years above)
- b. **INDIVIDUAL DOWNHILL**
 - i. Men Elite (17 years above)
 - ii. Women Elite (17 years above)
 - iii. Men Master (30 years above)

4. PAYMENT OF THE FINALE OVERALL PRIZE MONEY, MEDALS AND CHAMPION JERSEYS (SHARED EQUALLY BY THE PARTICIPATING ORGANISERS)

- a. **OVERALL WINNER FOR XCO AND DHI** for 1st, 2nd and 3rd placing will be given Prize monies, Medals and Overall Winner Jersey for the Overall Champion for the following categories only
 - i. **MEN ELITE (XCO & DHI)**
 - ii. **WOMEN ELITE (XCO & DHI)**
 - iii. **MEN JUNIOR (XCO only)**
 - iv. **WOMEN JUNIOR (XCO only)**
 - v. **MEN MASTER (XCO & DHI)**

- b. Each of the organizer in the series will have to **contribute equally** to the total amount of the Finale Overall Prize Monies, Overall Champion Medals and Overall Champion jerseys
- c. The amount of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placing Overall Winner prize monies will follow the minimum **UCI Financial Obligation for Group 1 Federation**

- d. In the case where a top ranking rider is not participating in the Finale ASIA MTB SERIES, he or she will **not be eligible** to claim the Prize monies, Medals and Champion Jersey. The unclaimed monies will be brought forward to the next year Overall prize money.
- e. Riders who have not paid up their registration fees will not be eligible to collect the prize monies.

5. PAYMENT OF THE EVENT WEBSITE (SHARED EQUALLY BY THE PARTICIPATING ORGANISERS)

- a. ASIA MTB SERIES website was developed by Mr Pratomo Setyadi of Indonesia and will be followed up by Mr Marvin Jay Cheng of the Philippines
- b. Each organizer will be given their own password to the website
- c. The **yearly website fee** will be shared equally by all the participating organizers

6. MANAGEMENT

- a. ASIA MOUNTAIN BIKE SERIES will currently be regulated by the following persons
 - i. Mr Marvin Jay Cheng of Philippines (*for website updates*)
 - ii. Ms Brittney Adlynn R Anang of Malaysia (*for points and results updates*)
 - iii. Ms Beatrice Alfred Lajawa (*for coordinating with UCI*)
- b. Each host organizers will initiate to chair and call for a meeting during their event to discuss collectively on any matters pertaining on what needs to be improved, problems encountered and the next course of action for the coming series
- c. The calendar for the following year will be discussed amongst the organizers
- d. The Appointed Organizer's Representatives for the current year will make up the Committee Members of the Asia Mountain Bike Series of the said year.

7. ORGANISING THE SERIES

Each organizer will organize their event independently

- a. Each organizer will appoint their own UCI and National Commissaires apart from the President of the Commissaire's Panel which will be appointed by the UCI
- b. Each organizer can add their own national categories with their own Winner Jersey eg. Youth, Masters (according to age classifications)
- c. Each organizer can award series winner jersey with own design and sponsor for their race
- d. Each organizer is free to appoint their own sponsors
- e. Each organizer can come up with their own package for accommodation, food and transportation
- f. Each organizer can set up their own account and mode of payments. Minimum Registration Fee for each entry is 30 USD per person and it can be adjusted as per event class. A penalty fee of USD20 per person will be imposed for late registration (less than 1 week before the event).

8. EVENT LOGO

- a. Each organizer is free to come up with their own design and logo **in addition** to the Asia Mountain Bike Series logo.
- b. Each organizer will include the ASIA MOUNTAINBIKE SERIES logo in their event

Riders Eligibility

Only UCI Licensed riders are eligible to ride the ASIA MTB Series.

UCI JUNIOR WORLD XCO SERIES

Only Junior riders with 2017 UCI License are eligible to ride in the Junior XCO series of the ASIA MTB SERIES

ASIA MTB SERIES

Anyone can ride and have the chance to win the Top awards in a specific category regardless of nationality. The **ASIA MTB SERIES Overall Title** rider eligibility is however only for **ASIAN riders** (according to **Passport Nationality**) as specified in the **Awards and Recognition**.

Prize Money for the Top 5 of each category shall be based on UCI Financial Obligation for UCI Junior World XCO series.

Prize Money for the Top 5 of each category shall be based on the UCI Financial Obligation according to the host country's Federation Group.

ASIA MTB SERIES OVERALL WINNER

The ASIA MTB Series Overall winners are only for the UCI recognized categories. This is eligible **ONLY** to **ASIAN** nationality (according to passport nationality). Prize Money will be awarded to the Top 3 ASIA Overall Classification which is counted from points received in each series. Medals are awarded to the Top 3 ASIA MTB Series Overall Classification winner. Champion Jerseys are awarded to the ASIA MTB Series Overall Winners.

The prize monies to be awarded by the Finale organizer to the OVERALL WINNER will be shared equally by the ASIA MTB Series organizers for the year

** The Overall Champion winners are obligated to wear the jersey in the following year series unless he or she is also the Current Series, Continental or World Champion.*

- In the event of a tie in points, the rider who won in the latest series will be deemed the Overall ASIA MTB Series Winner.*

Series Points and Prize Money

- The SERIES POINTS will be awarded the 1st to 10th positions in each categories and disciplines as follows

20 – 18 – 16 – 14 – 12 – 10 – 8 – 6 – 4 – 2

- UCI Points for Men and Women Elite in the Cross Country and Downhill will be awarded by UCI according to the class registered by each organiser as follows

2.1 Men & Women Elite C3 – Cross Country & Downhill

10 – 6 – 4 – 2 – 1

2.2 Men & Women Elite C2 – Cross Country & Downhill

30 – 20 – 15 – 12 – 10 – 8 – 6 – 4 – 2 – 1

2.3 Men & Women Elite C1 – Cross Country & Downhill

60 – 40 – 30 – 25 – 20 – 18 – 16 – 14 – 12 – 10 – 8 – 6 – 4 – 2 – 1

2.4 Men & Women Elite – Cross Country & Downhill (National Championship)

110 – 90 – 70 – 60 – 50 – 40 – 30 – 20 – 10 - 5

3. UCI Junior XCO Series will be awarded by UCI to the top 25 junior riders in the Cross Country event
90 – 70 – 60 – 50 – 40 – 35 – 30 – 27 – 24 – 22 - 20 – 18 – 16 – 14 – 12 – 10 – 9 – 8 – 7 – 6 – 5 – 4 - 3 - 2 – 1

6. The **FINALE** prize monies (1st to 3rd position only) will follow the minimum UCI Financial Obligation for Class 2 for Junior, Elite and Men Master categories for ASIA MTB Series, and UCI Junior World XCO Series 2017 (if registered), to be payable via bank account of the winners.
